Descriptions Below

Love: (a great interest and pleasure in something or someone)

John 13:34 – A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.

Joy: (a feeling of great pleasure and happiness)

John 15:11 – I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.

Peace: (calm, freedom from disturbance)

1 Thessalonians 5:13 – Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work. Live in peace with each other.

Patience: (the capacity to accept delay)

Romans 8:25 – But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently.

Kindness: (the quality of being friendly, generous, and considerate)

2 Peter 1:7 – and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love.

Goodness: (the quality of being good, honest, truthful, virtuous)

2 Thessalonians 1:11 – With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith.

Faithfulness: (complete trust or confidence in someone or something)

Hebrews 11:1 – Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

Gentleness: (the quality of being kind, tender or mild-mannered)

Titus 3:2 – To slander no one, to be peaceable and considerate, and always to be gentle toward everyone.

<u>Self-Control</u>: (the ability to control oneself: emotions, expressions, behavior)

Titus **2**:6 – Similarly, encourage the young men to be self-controlled.



MEMORIZATION SCRIPTURES: Gratitude

(Grades K – 2nd Recite 1st scripture only. Grades 3rd – 6th Recite 1st five scriptures. Grades 7th – 12th Recite all scriptures.)

- 1. Colossians 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.
- 2. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
- 3. Philippians 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your request to God.
- 4. Psalm 106:47 Save us, Lord our God, and gather us from the nations, that we may give thanks to your holy name and glory in your praise.
- 5. Hebrews 12:28 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe.
- 6. Hebrews 13:15 Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.
- 7. Psalm 7:17 I will give thanks to the Lord because of his righteousness; I will sing the praises of the name of the Lord most high.
- 8. Psalm 54:6 I will sacrifice a freewill offering to you; I will praise your name, Lord, for it is good.
- 9. Psalm 28:7 The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and he helps me. My heart leaps for joy, and with my song I praise him.
- 10. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? ... Therefore honor God with your bodies.


