4. Matthew 5:6 **Blessed** are **those who hunger and thirst for righteousness**: for they will be filled.
5. Matthew 5:7 **Blessed** are **the merciful**: for they will be shown mercy.
6. Matthew 5:8 **Blessed** are **the pure in heart**: for they will see God.
7. Matthew 5:9 **Blessed** are **the peacemakers**: for they will be called the children of God.

1. Philippians 4:13 - I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.
2. Psalm 31:24 – Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the Lord.
3. 2 Timothy 1:7 - For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love, and self-discipline.
4. Psalm 23:4 – Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
5. Deuteronomy 31:6 – Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you.
6. Psalm 27:14 – Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord.
7. 1 Corinthians 16:13 – Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong.
8. Ephesians 6:11 – Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes.
9. Proverbs 3:5 – Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.
10. Mark 5:36 – Overhearing what they said, Jesus told him, “Don’t be afraid; just believe.”

3. Exodus 20:7 **You shall not misuse the name of the Lord...**
4. Exodus 20:8 **Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.**
5. Exodus 20:12 **Honor thy father and thy mother....**
6. Exodus 20:13 **You shall not kill.**
7. Exodus 20:14 **You shall not commit adultery.**
8. Exodus 20:15 **You shall not steal.**
9. Exodus 20:16 **You shall not give false testimony against thy neighbor.**

Answer: All who hope in the Lord. Scripture: Psalm 31:24
  
  - 3) Why don't you have to fear evil walking through the darkest valley?  
Answer: Because God is with me, and I am comforted by His rod and staff. Scripture: Psalm 23:4
  
  - 4) Why should I be strong and courageous and not be afraid or terrified of people?  
Answer: Because God goes with me and will never leave or forsake me. Scripture: Deuteronomy 31:6
  
  - 5) Why should I wait on the Lord and be of good courage?  
Answer: Because God will strengthen my heart. Scripture: 27:14
  
  - 6) What did Paul write to the church of God in Corinth in the scripture 1 Corinthians 16:13?  
Answer: Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong. Scripture: 1 Corinthians 16:13
