

You're invited to join the Biblical Champions in an experience of praising God by studying His Word. God's Word is then instilled in the hearts of all participants; Kindergarten through Twelfth grade students. Gold, silver, or bronze medals are awarded to "all" participants, based upon their achievements for displaying their knowledge of God's Word. Participants register and receive study material before the Biblical Champions event. And, may log on to weekly zoom lessons by emailing biblicalchampions@gmail.com for zoom link. On the day of the event, knowledge learned from the study material is displayed by participation in events, i.e., Service, Memorization and Bible Quiz. Participants earn one point for every correct answer.

The Biblical Champions Savings Seed is a financial incentive program to encourage financial literacy and motivate children to build savings for higher education and learning opportunities. This is a challenge to motivate children to obtain results by applying themselves. This gift will be awarded to 3 participants: one in the K-2nd grades age group, one in the 3rd-6th grades age group and one in the 7th-12th grades age group in the form of a \$500 deposit into a High Yielding CD Savings Account in the child's name. It will be announced two weeks after event to allow for review of essays and speeches.

- 2. Display full knowledge of the study guide by earning a gold medal.
- 3. Submit a one-page essay on annual topic. (In written form and same essay in a 1-minute speech {video}.) Topic will be announced in the Spring of 2024.
