

2024 Biblical Champions Savings Seed

Topic to be announced in Spring of 2024

Biblical Champions Savings Seed is the financial incentive component to encourage financial literacy and motivate children to build savings for higher education and learning opportunities. This is a challenge to motivate children to obtain results by applying themselves. The award is a \$500 CD Account opened in the child's name. The criteria to earn this award is to:

- 1. Participate in current Biblical Champions event and earn a gold medal.
- 2. Complete four Acts of Kindness (community/family service). Form must include description of the service that was performed and be submitted on annual event day.
- 3. A one page essay on annual Biblical Champions Savings Seed topic must be submitted by annual event day.
- 4. A one-minute video of speech on annual Biblical Champions Savings Seed topic must be submitted by annual event day. (Include brief introduction of yourself and recap of topic.)

Oral Speech Tips

Introduce yourself (Name, age, school, and grade, what do you want to be when you grow up.). What do the topic and scripture(s) mean to you? If awarded the savings seed, what is your plan for making it grow? What are your personal goals for your savings seed?

Essay Tips

Write clear complete sentences that start with capital letters and end with periods (.). Write an introduction paragraph explaining what you will write about. Write one or more body paragraphs with supporting details. And write a conclusion paragraph summarizing your essay. Start each new paragraph indented or after a blank line.

Selection of one child in each of the three age groups (K-2nd grades, 3rd-6th grades, and 7th-12th grades) will be announced two weeks after event to allow for review of submissions.
